Hashem, the sponsor of H.B. 2433, for introducing the bill and ask your own legislators to help it get scheduled for a hearing!** H.B. 2433 was triple referred to the House Committees on Health, Consumer Protection and Judiciary on February 1, 2016. **The new law, already passed in ten other states,** would provide a state exemption for those non- invasive complementary and alternative health care practitioners who avoid a specific list of prohibited conduct, such as puncturing the skin or administering prescription drugs or telling people to go off their treatments recommended by their licensed health care professional, and who give out the disclosure information listed in the bill, such as contact information, education and training, and the nature of the services to be rendered.
