It was our second lobby day to oppose SF380 and HF393 and many organizations and individuals worked to collaborate and get all the tasks accomplished! What Next - Where the bills are at:

The House bill, HF393, was introduced in January by Representative Freiberg and referred to the House Health and Human Services Reform Committee, on January 29. **The Chair of that Committee, Representative Tara Mack**, did not put the bill on her agenda by the March 20th deadline so it is our expectation that the bill will not move further in the House unless the Senate bill is passed and is sent to the House or unless they amend the bill onto another moving bill.

The Senate bill, SF380, was introduced in January by Senator Eaton, and referred to the Senate Health, Human Services and Housing Committee, on January 29. **The Chair of the Committee, Kathy Sheran,** put SF 380 on the agenda of the Senate Health, Human Services and Housing Committee, and the bill passed on a vote of 6 - 4 with one abstention. The bill is now a potential candidate for being heard on the full Senate Floor for a vote, and we are hoping that the bill will not get a vote in the Senate and will die at the end of session. Senator Eaton, author of SF 380, offered a "Delete-all" amendment, and the new version of the bill has additional provisions in addition to the original language as follows:

The bill now also requires parents to write a statement of why they choose not to have their child receive a vaccine and to have that statement recorded in the child's medical record

- The bill raises questions of data privacy for those parents who choose exemptions
- Amendments to improve parental informed consent, and protect physician independence, were rejected
- ► The bill still allows a physician to refuse to sign the certificate, which could lead to "doctor-shopping" and, therefore, increased costs and coercion for parents
- ► The bill may have negative repercussions on physicians who sign certificates for patients requesting exemptions

Please help us keep the pressure on! Stand up for vaccine health freedom rights and show the legislators that we won't let them obstruct or restrict our rights!!! Take Action on SF 380 by sending a letter of opposition to the MN Senate <u>here</u>.
