Take Action to Stop S.B. 277! Sign Petition for Governor Veto NOW!!!

Senate Bill 277, mandating all vaccinations for all schoolchildren regardless of their parents' personal or religious beliefs, passed on a 46:30 vote in the Assembly yesterday. The Senate's concurrence vote, a vote to approve the bill again, is expected on Monday and then S.B. 277 will be sent to Governor Jerry Brown for his signature. If enacted into law, California would join only two other states -- Mississippi and West Virginia -- that permit only medical exemptions as valid grounds for refusing one or more vaccinations.

Support the thousands of parents and concerned citizens who have rallied several times at the Capitol to oppose the legislation for violating their parental rights and the fundamental rights of bodily integrity and informed consent as well as their children's right to education which is a Constitutional right in the state of California. Although Governor Brown supported a more restrictive vaccine policy for CA in 2012 when he signed AB 2109, which required parents who wanted to exempt their children from the shots to be educated by and obtain a signature from a health care professional first, there is still reason to hope he will veto SB 277. Along with his signature to AB 2109, Brown directed the state's Department of Public Health to exempt people "whose religious beliefs preclude vaccinations" from the educational and signature mandate. Unfortunately, his suggestion did not carry any legal weight and it was never implemented; nevertheless, his concern for religious exemptions in 2012 may be an indication that he won't sign SB 277.
