# FOUR STATES Need Your Immediate Action Help Pass Genetically Modified Organisms (GMO) Labeling Bills!

SUPPORT Connecticut, New Jersey, Rhode Island, and Vermont in GMO-labeling bills! Bills moving in these four states would place the burden of disclosure on the manufacturers by requiring a label for GMO containing foods. Currently there is no law requiring the labeling of foods containing or produced with genetically modified organisms. Without such disclosure mandates, manufacturers may voluntarily inform consumers of products containing GMOs but most are choosing not to do so. Some consumer-friendly manufacturers and independent organizations assume the burden of labeling products without GMOs by labeling them as "GMO-free". Click on a State to Take Action NOW! **CONNECTICUT House Bill No. 5117, mandating labeling of GMO foods,** was passed favorably out of the Joint House and Senate Environmental Committee and sent to the House floor on 3/21/2012. H.B. 5117 will likely be heard in other committees before moving back to the House Floor and to the Senate. **RHODE ISLAND House Bill No. 7494, mandating labeling of GMO foods,** was introduced on February 9, 2012 and was referred to the House Health, Education and Welfare Committee. On March 14, 2012, the House HEW Committee recommended HB 7494 be held for further

#### Hawaii GMO bills:

H.B. 2031 Requires any genetically-engineered food products that is sold, offered for sale, or distributed in the State to be labeled as a genetically-engineered food product.

S.B. 2279 Prohibits the sale or distribution of any genetically engineered whole food intended for human consumption unless the food is labeled as genetically engineered. Defines "genetically engineered food crop", "modern biotechnology", and "genetically engineered whole food".

**S.B. 2443** Requires, beginning 01/01/13, specific labeling for any food or raw agricultural commodity sold in the State that contains or was produced with a genetically engineered material.

**S.B. 2478** Requires genetically engineered food products that are sold, offered for sale, or distributed in this State to be labeled as such, with certain exceptions. Defines "genetically engineered food product." Establishes penalties for violations.

**S.B. 2891** Establishes labeling requirements for any food or raw agricultural commodity sold in the State that contains a genetically engineered material, or was produced with a genetically engineered material; establishes exceptions; establishes violations; requires director of health to adopt rules.

**H.B. 1013** Requires all food and food product labels to include whether certain hormone growth substances are contained in such food or whether such food contains any product which is genetically modified

**H.B. 2088** Requires all food and food products sold in Missouri that are or contain genetically modified products to be labeled indicating that the food is or contains genetically modified products.

**H.B. 3678** Requires the labeling of foods containing and produced with genetically engineered material and prescribes penalties.

\*Representative Towns offered this bill in past sessions as well but it never moved due to lack of a senate sponsor; therefore encourage your representatives in the Senate to work with Representative Towns.

**H.B. 733** Establishes a cause of action in trespass against the manufacturer of a genetically engineered seed or genetically engineered plant part when such seed or plant part enters the property of a person engaged in an agricultural activity and causes damages and provides that indemnification clauses in seed contracts are against public policy and are void and unenforceable and that seed contracts shall not include venue clauses that provide that a dispute under a seed contract shall be governed by the laws of a state other than Vermont.

**H.B. 2180** Creates the Genetically Engineered Crop and Animal Farmer Protection Act and sets forth information requirements regarding the sale of genetically engineered seeds; plants and animals; identifies certain contractual provisions to be against public policy; prevents noncompetitive practices involving technology fees; establishes measures to be taken to avoid cross pollination of genetically engineered plants and seeds; requires genetically engineered seeds to be so labeled; prohibits loan discrimination, provides for civil and citizen suits.
