GREAT NEWS! Call Michigan Governor Snyder Ask Him to Sign House Bill 4688 REPEALING Michigan's Restrictive Dietitian Law

Congratulations Michigan for passing the Groundbreaking Dietitian REPEAL bill HB4688 out of the House and Senate. HB 4688 repeals a restrictive monopolistic licensing bill that allowed only dietitians to give nutrition advice to consumers, making it a crime for other citizens to provide nutrition recommendations. The Governor's signature is the last step in this 8-year journey to repeal the law since the law passed.
