In 2024, threats to health freedom persist, but so does the momentum for change. Across the country, more citizens are stepping up, standing together, and taking action. From coast to coast, advocates are not only resisting ongoing efforts to restrict our rights—they're advancing bold, proactive legislation to protect them.

NHFA attorneys have assisted local groups in MA, VT, CA, IN, and MD working on right to refuse legislation that protects bodily autonomy.

Right to Refuse by Numbers 2020-2024

49 states across the nation have filed over

1380 bills that explicitly PROTECT bodily autonomy.

29 states have passed a total of 83 new laws, plus 9 resolutions.



8 new laws were passed in 2024!

There are still many states where protective bills have not been passed into law. In many states coercive medical mandates are still happening today, and access to employment or education is still contingent on getting a particular vaccine; so our work to guide state groups that want to make changes to their laws to protect health freedom remains urgent.

This is a huge step in the right direction but there is much more work to be done if we hope to shape a future where all people can freely make their own health decisions without coercive tactics.

NHFA protects the right of practitioners to practice the healing arts

Safe harbor practitioner exemption legislation protects access to healers. These laws ensure that complementary and alternative health care practitioners such as traditional naturopaths, homeopaths, energy medicine practitioners, and herbalists cannot be shut down or criminally charged for practicing their vocations without state licenses, as long as they avoid a list of prohibited acts and as long as they give out proper disclosures to their clients.

NHFA works with groups all over the country to introduce and advance safe harbor bills.

In 2024 NHFA attorneys assisted six states in the process of working towards the passage of Safe Harbor Practitioner Exemption Bills that would protect the right of complementary and alternative health care practitioners to practice and be accessible to consumers: Massachusetts, Connecticut, Florida, Indiana, Oklahoma, and Oregon.

The Safe Harbor Practitioner
Exemption bill introduced in
Massachusetts in 2023 was reported
favorably out of the Public Health
Committee but unfortunately,
the Health Care Financing Committee
sent it to study in 2024. It has been
filed again for 2025-2026 session!

Currently eleven states have passed a safe harbor exemption law in some form, including: Minnesota, Rhode Island, California, Louisiana, Idaho, Oklahoma, Arizona (for homeopaths), New Mexico, Colorado, Nevada and Maine. Our goal is all 50 states!

NHFA publishes action alerts

One of the most crucial actions individuals can take to influence our country's laws and safeguard health freedom is to engage with lawmakers, build relationships with them, and advocate for legislation that protects health freedom while opposing laws that threaten health freedom.

NHFA's advocacy software gives us the ability to publish action alerts to keep everyone informed and give them a way to write directly to their lawmakers.

In 2024 NHFA put out hundreds of thousands of action alerts targeting key lawmakers in states across the nation to: support safe harbor practitioner legislation and to oppose unnecessary practitioner licensing.

Many state alerts went out regarding bodily autonomy and the right to decline unwanted mandates.

In addition, alerts were sent regarding federal issues including FCC licensing of wireless spectrum and protecting small famers and ranchers from forced electronic ID for cattle.

NHFA is getting the word out

Educational outreach remains central to NHFA's mission. Together with our sister organization, National Health Freedom Coalition (NHFC), NHFA gave numerous presentations in 2024

helping people understand how laws impact their freedoms and how they can become active in driving policy changes.
